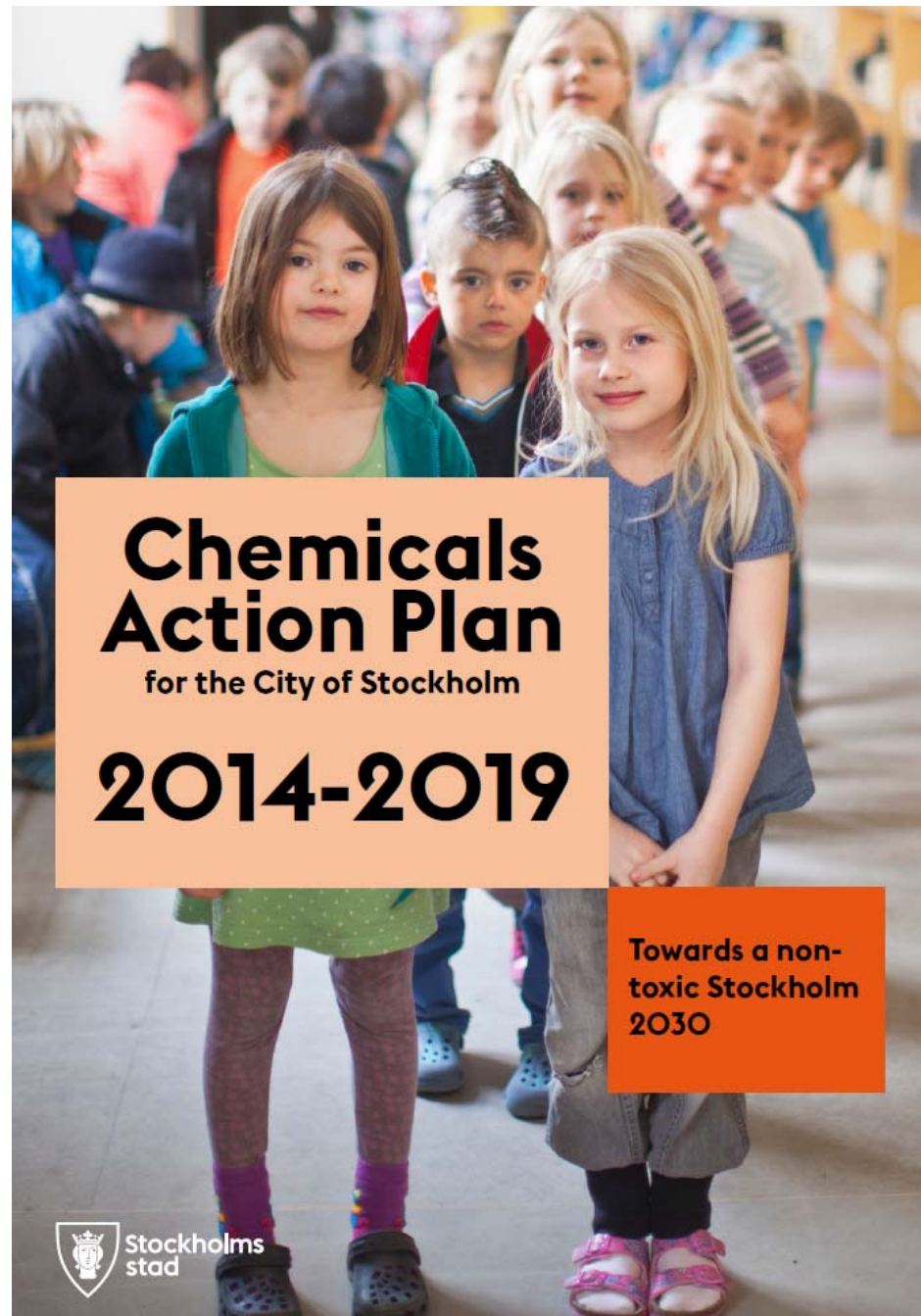

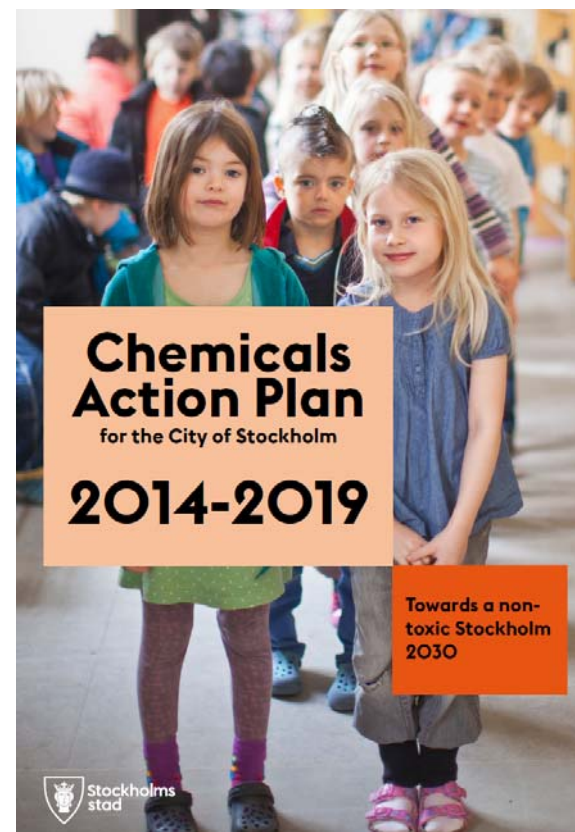

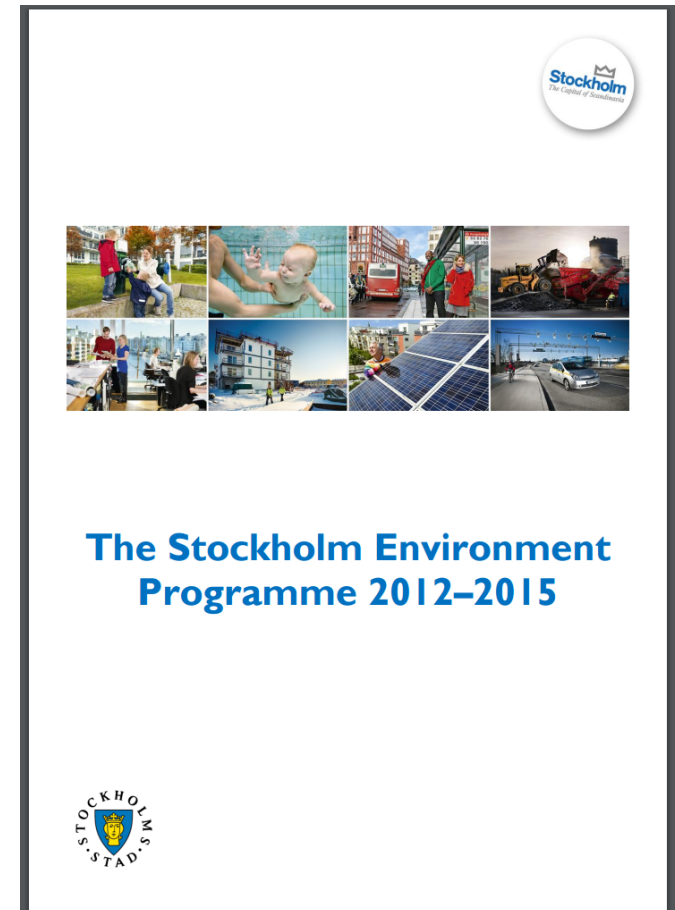

Environment programme

- Interim targets in Environment programme 2012-2015:
 - The contents of substances that are dangerous to the environment and to health will be reduced in procured goods
 - Emissions of dangerous substances from buildings and facilities will be reduced

Previous projects

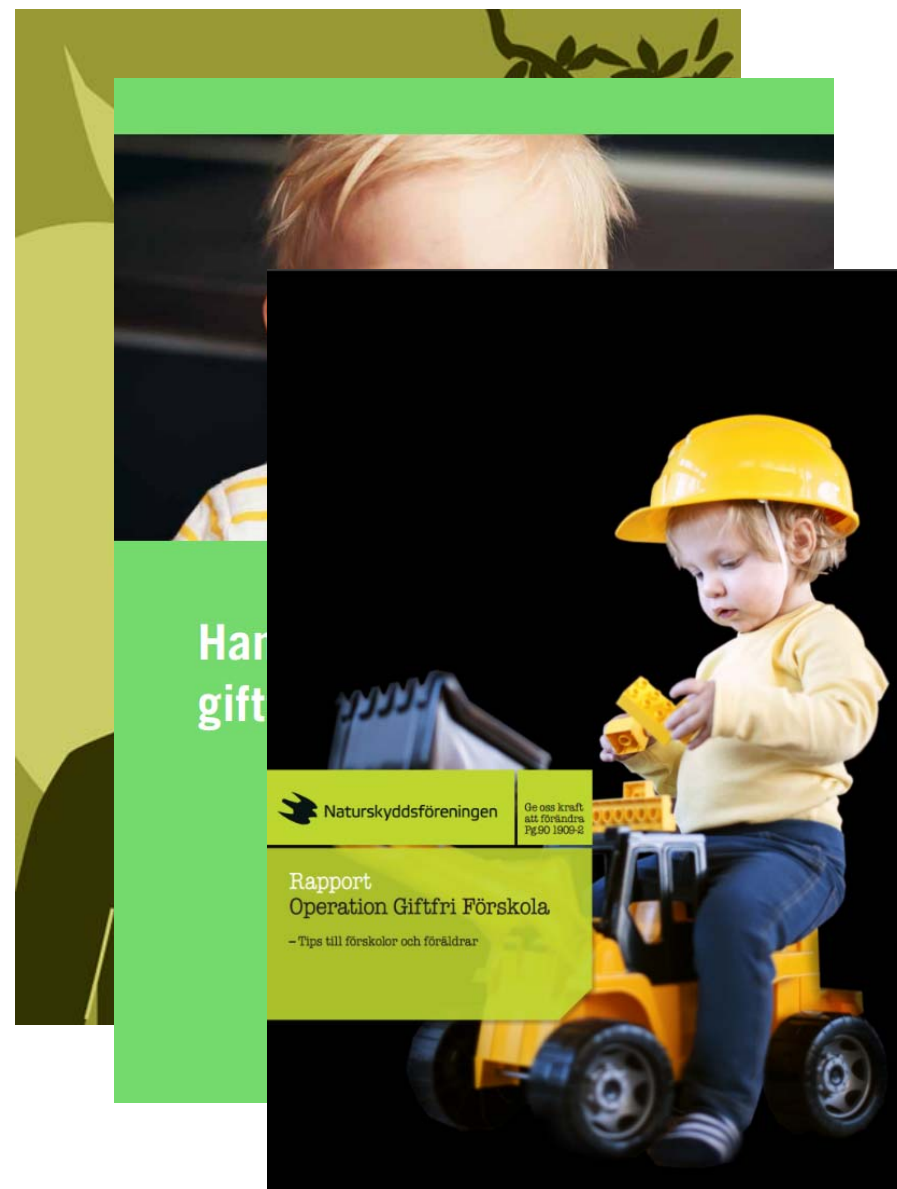
- New pollutants - new tools 2004-08
 - City financed project
 - 20+ research studies
- ScorePP 2006-09
 - EU 6th framework programme
 - Focus on priority pollutants under the water framework directive
- COHIBA 2008-11
 - EU Baltic Sea Region programme
 - Focus on pollutants of the Baltic Sea Action Plan

National level

- National environmental objective "A non-toxic environment" - Parliament
- Action plan for a toxic-free everyday environment – Chemicals Agency
- Operation Non-toxic pre-schools - SSCN



Child focus

Substances

- Properties:
 - Phase-out substances
 - Priority risk-reduction substances
- Local focus substances – specific substances
